


TALENT AUCTION & BRUNCH & SUNDAY SCHOOL KICK OFF SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12

Wandering thoughts of a Wayward Follower of Jesus...

Giving has always been part of religious life. In old testament times it was the giving of offerings (i.e. the first fruits of the harvest) or animals for sacrifices. It was and is our way of giving back to God a small portion of what we get every day from our Lord, His Grace. I am not writing here to talk about how much one should give. Any giving we do, regardless of what it is or its worth is only as good as the intent behind the gift. In other words... is our giving from the heart? Giving is an integral part of our faith life. As Methodist's, we pledge our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness as a member of a local congregation. I believe in a sacrificial giving attitude rather than just following a tithing practice.

Currently, if you come to church on Sunday you can put cash or a check in the offering plate or TEXT an offering. If you don't come to church, you can mail a check in to the church, do a direct deposit, go online and gift, or TEXT an offering. You can also drop-off an offering as well during regular church office hours. I am not asking anyone to change how they are currently giving to the church. I am as Jesus would say, "Very Truly I tell you..." you have no excuse on a practical level not to give to the ministry of our Lord and Savior. These giving tools also extend beyond our Sunday giving. Special giving like memorials, or special giving to specific mission projects, or as we undertake our Audio & Visual Project you can give directly to that project through our online giving tools. And of course, financial giving is not the only way to give. Our Time and Talents are critical as well. They are a direct connection to our Lord who gave them to you to use in His name.

I believe the easier we can make it to give whether it is monetary, time, or talents the more giving we will receive. That is assuming our hearts are in the right place as well. Are you giving to the Lord's work from your leftovers or from your first fruits? If you use a budget type financial plan does this giving have a line, a slot, a category in that budget. That talent you have whether it is being used to make a living or just as a hobby, is the Lord's works reaping any reward from it?

As I mentioned earlier, I believe in a sacrificial giving attitude. Tithing is a sound biblical practice and for many it not an obtainable goal at this time. But it is not the amount or the percentage of the gift that matters but the condition of one's heart behind that gift that matters, yes I am repeating myself! Along with that sacrificial attitude there also must be a sense of trust. You are sitting in church and the offering plate is coming... you only have a one-dollar bill and a twenty-dollar bill... what will you give? What will you give if you only have a twenty-dollar bill? Nothing? Are you trusting that God will provide? My hope is giving is an integral part of your faith journey and I am here to help you in this or any other part our faith journey that you may need assistance in. We are one body, when one is hurting we all hurt. To God Be the Glory. ~ Pastor Buck

To give, search your phone's app store for "GivePlus+" by Vanco Payment Solutions and install. Follow the instructions to select our church and start giving.

TEXT Giving

Simply text a dollar amount (i.e. "10" for \$10.00) to <u>855-908-1102</u>. First time users will get a reply text with a link. Click on the link and complete the transaction form. The dollar amount you texted will be the amount processed. Future giving will automatically process using the information you entered initially. You will get a confirmation TEXT which will have other instructions for refunding or making your gift a recurring gift. Go to our website to view a video on how to text to give.

Electronic Giving Option

To simplify your financial giving to CUMC, consider using electronic giving through your own bank's website (online bill paying) or authorizing CUMC's account at Vision Bank to draw funds from your account. You can set up an amount for as often as you like or make single donations.




